

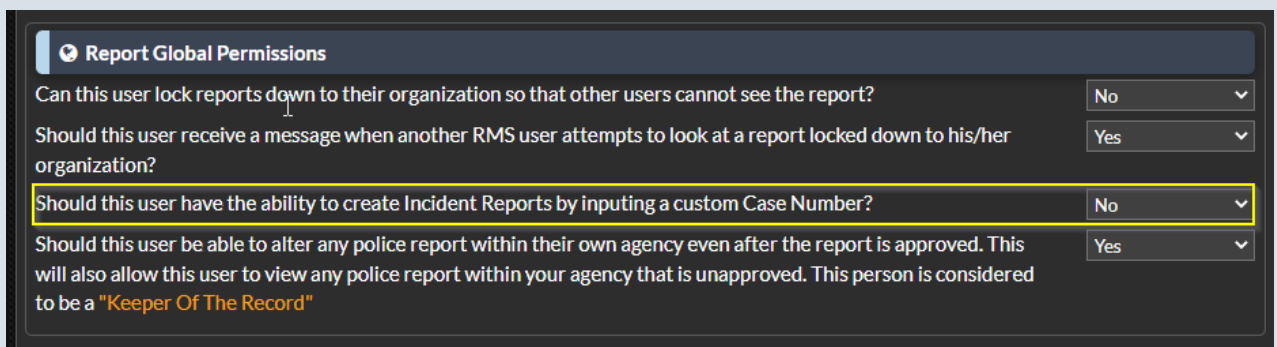
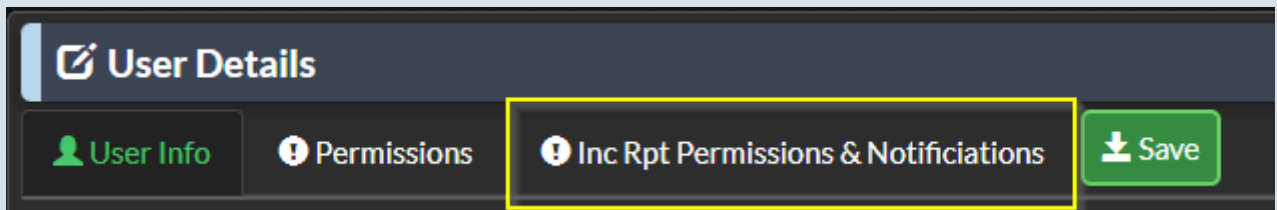

NEW FEATURES

- Incident Reports
 - A global report permission has been created to allow users to Create Incident Reports from the Incident Report page. If this permission is set to "No" for a user, the user is still able to create an Incident Report from the Calls for Service module.



Figures 1 and 2 - Incident Reports

- o On an Incident Report, the following fields can now be configured to be required: Arrest Location, Location Type, Officer Badge #, Officer Radio #, Signal, and Suspect Residential Address.

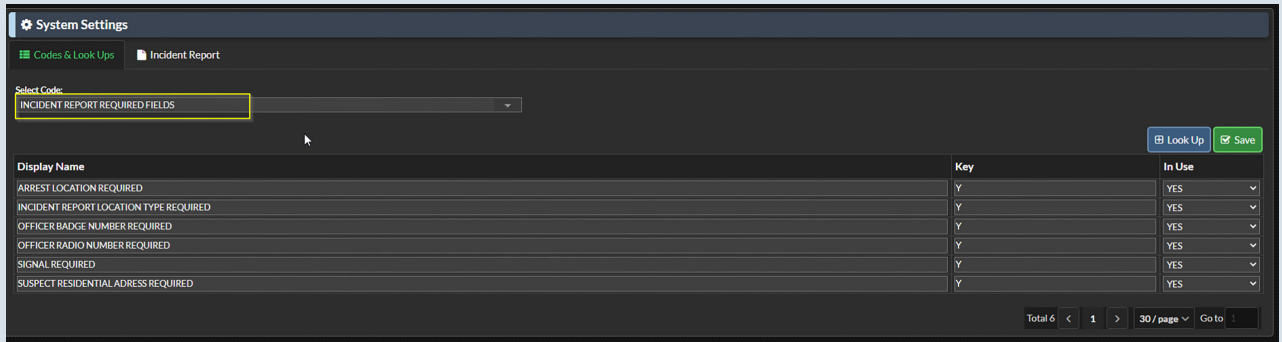


Figure 3 - Incident Report - Configurable Fields

- Warrants

- o Support for digitally capturing signatures on Misdemeanor and Felony Warrants has been implemented. A Topaz signature pad is needed to capture the signatures, which are stored within the users profile.

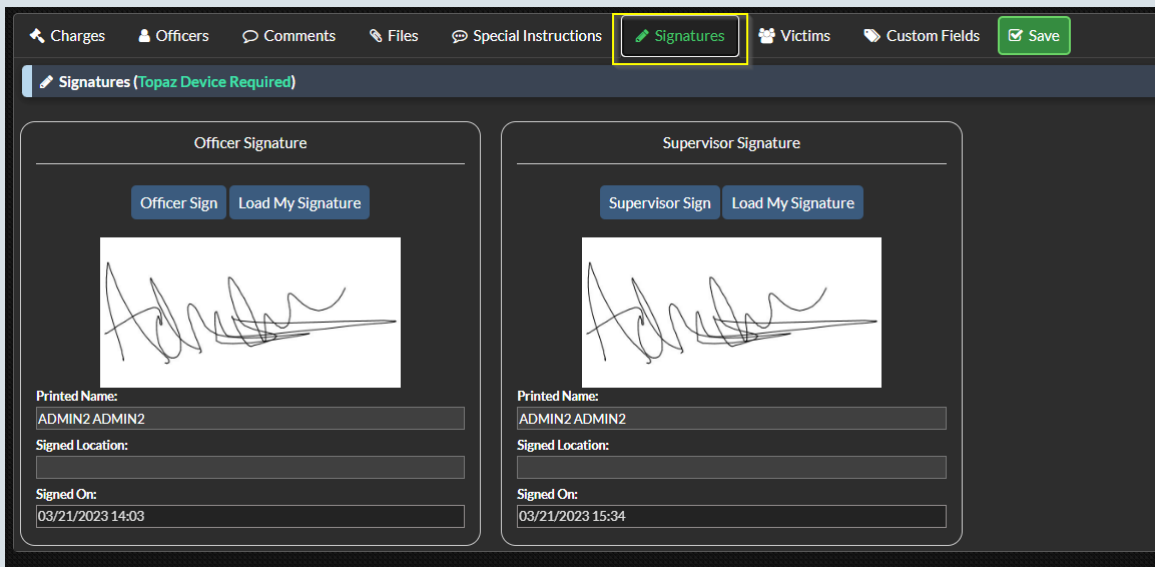


Figure 4 - Warrants - Support for Digitally Capturing Signatures

- o Warrants can now be locked or unlocked so that only users with the locked permission can view them.
 - If it is locked, all fields are disabled, except for Date Issued, Date Received, Status, Date Served, Date Arrested, Type, Court, as well as attaching files, special instructions, email officer button and comments. When locked, the action is being tracked in the action log table.
 - If the Warrant is unlocked, all the fields are re-enabled. If there are attached signatures when it is unlocked, those signatures will be removed and need to be recaptured due to details in the Warrant changing. When unlocked, the action is being tracked in the action log table.

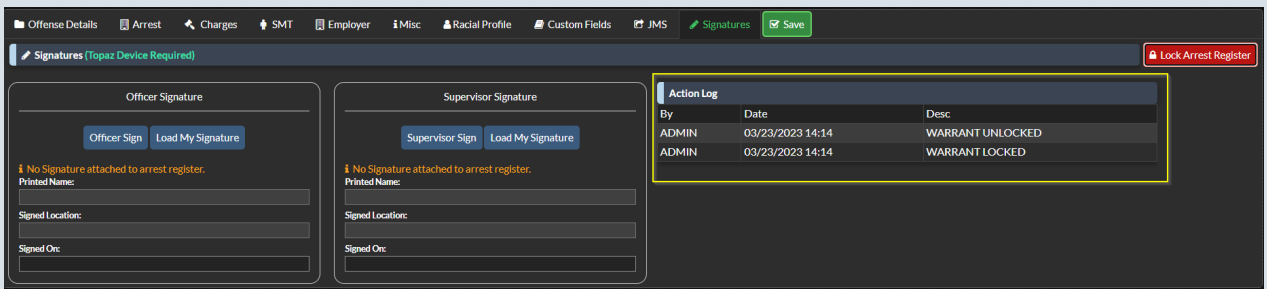


Figure 5 - Warrants - Action Log Table

- o Related victims can now be added to Warrants (if enabled).
- o Officers are now able to search by Case Number for approved Incident Reports, and with the new Import Details button, they can have the victims and charges auto-populated on the Warrant.

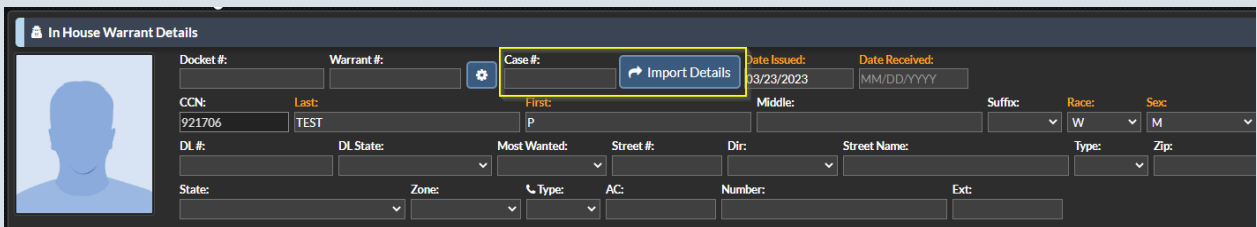


Figure 6 - Incident Reports - Import Details Button

- Arrest Register
 - o Support for digitally capturing signatures on Probable Cause Affidavits has been implemented. A Topaz signature pad is needed to capture the signatures, which are stored within the users profile.

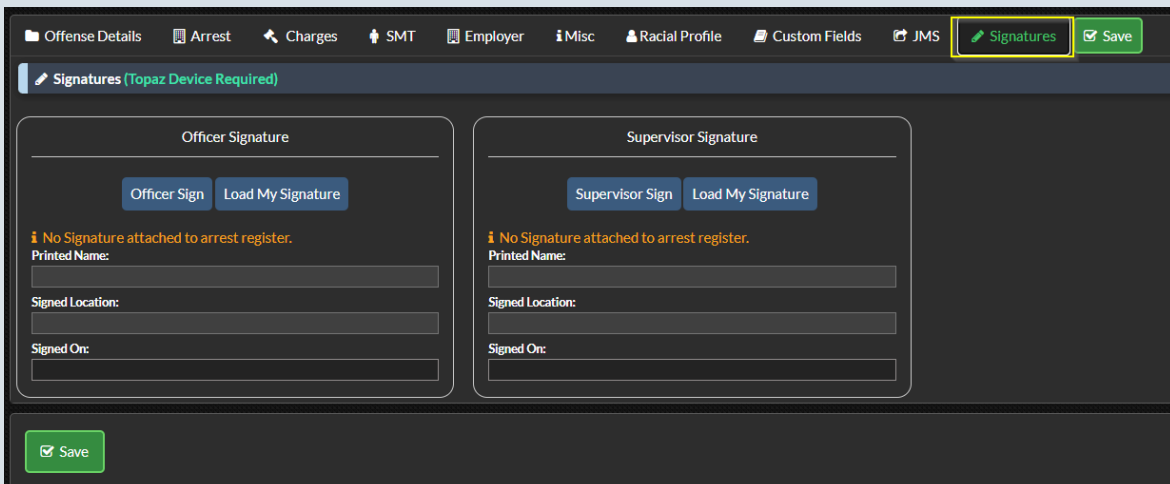


Figure 7 - Probable Cause Affidavits - Support for Digitally Capturing Signatures

- o Probable Cause Affidavits can now be locked or unlocked.
 - If it is locked, all fields are disabled for editing. When locked, the action is being tracked in the action log table.

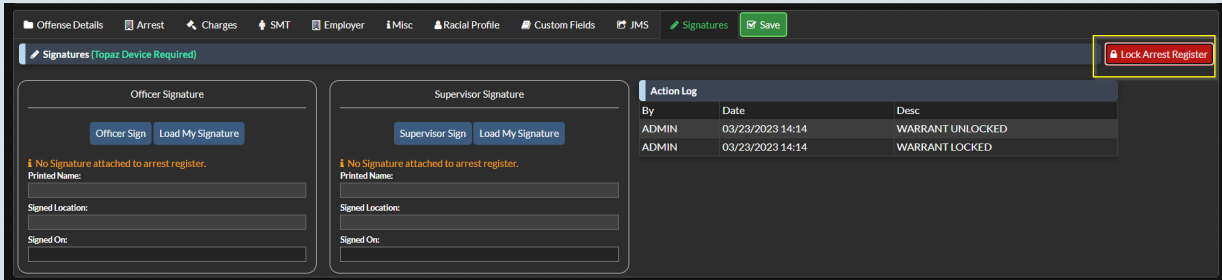


Figure 8 - Probable Cause Affidavits - Lock Arrest Register

- If the Warrant is unlocked, all the fields are re-enabled. If there are attached signatures when it is unlocked, those signatures will be removed and need to be recaptured due to details in the Affidavit changing. When unlocked, the action is being tracked in the action log table.

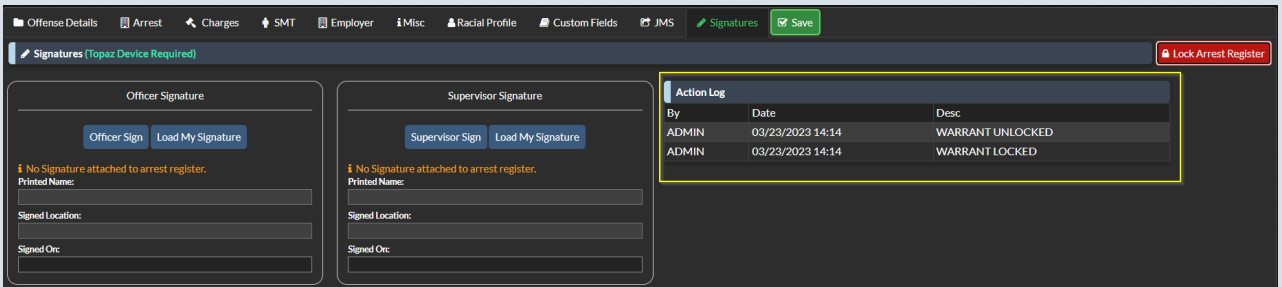


Figure 9 - Probable Cause Affidavits - Action Log Table

- User Management
 - o Admins are now able to copy the Incident Report Permission from one user to another.

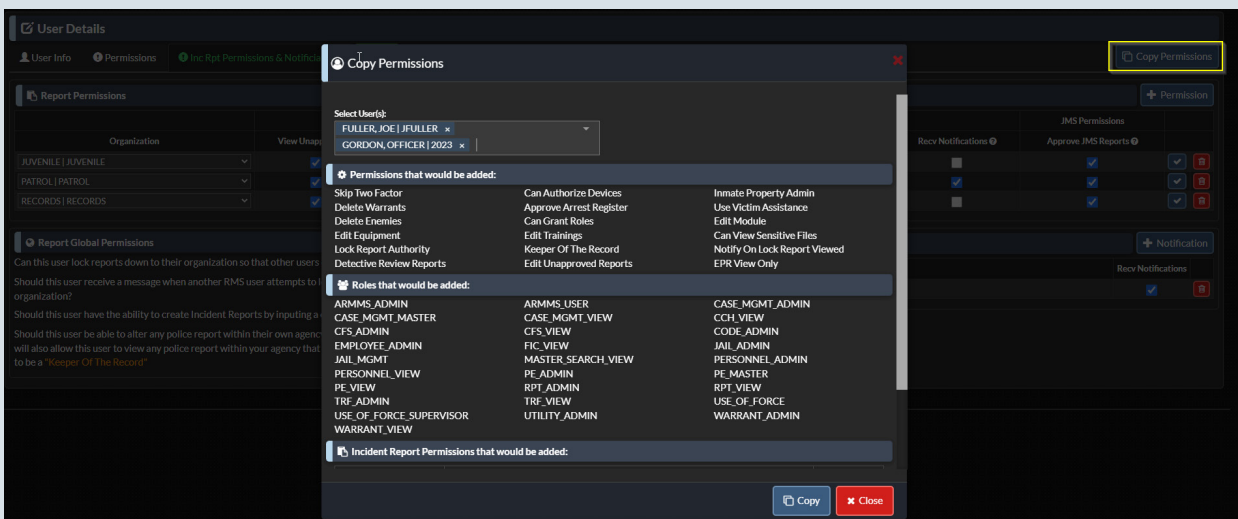


Figure 10 - User Management - Copy Incident Report Permissions

- The Arrest Count on the dashboard now always matches the recent arrests count.

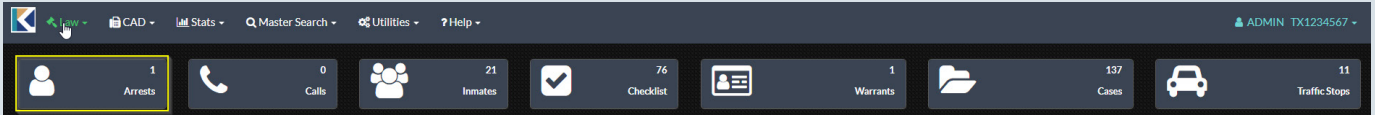



Figure 11 - Arrest Count

- When printing an approved report with multiple supplements and the last supplement was a Quick Supplement, an issue was corrected where the printed report used the Quick Supplement as the base report, resulting in missing information on the printed report.
- In Case Management, when searching for all "Open Cases", the cases that are assigned are highlighted green again.



- When sending a suspect from an Incident Report to an Arrest Register, the suspect's address information is now transferring correctly.

Figure 13 - Suspects Address Information

- An issue was corrected where the City and State were not always populating correctly when the Zip Code was added within several RMS modules.

- Users with the “Approve RMS Reports” permission are now allowed to add corrections to an incident report.

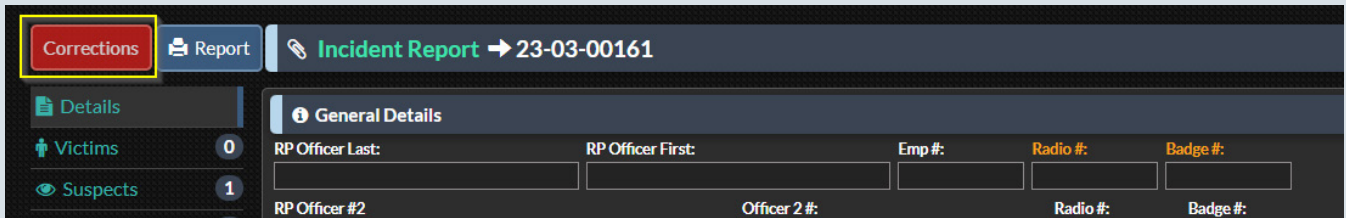


Figure 14 - Approve RMS Reports Permission

- When creating or editing a Warrant, the Direction lookup now has a blank option to select, so the user is able to leave that field blank.

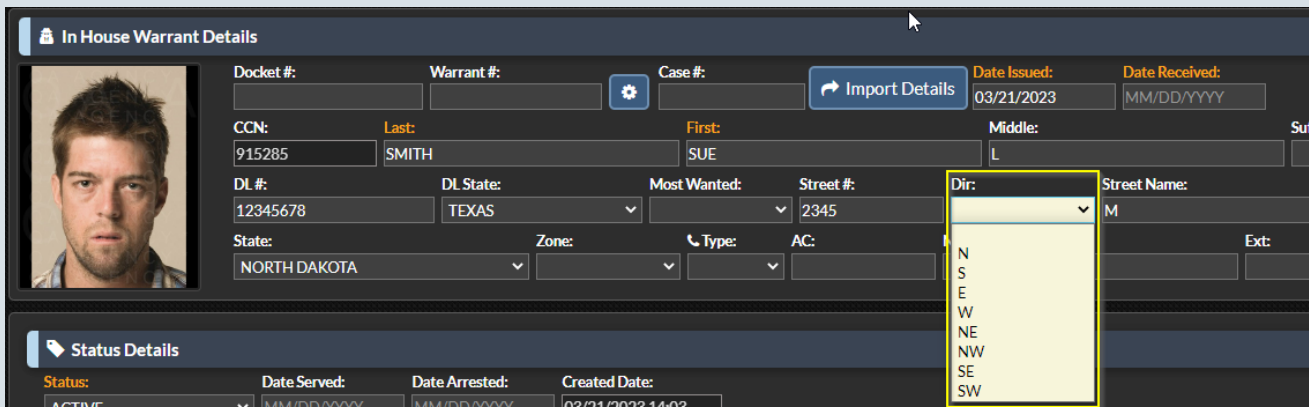


Figure 15 - Direction Lookup When Creating or Editing a Warrant

- An issue where the Street Type was duplicating at times on the Call Sheets has been corrected.
- In some cases, date of birth (DOB) was changing for DOB’s in April.
